**3:1-6 A Healed Hand and a Rising Plot**

- v.2 How many laws are given in the Torah against healing on the Sabbath?  
How many of the Rabbis' 39 types of forbidden work are against healing?

Why twelve apostles? (Isa. 44:24-28) Why three in the inner circle? (Deut. 19:15)

- v.14-15 "Apostles" = Plenipotentiary Ambassadors
