

The Gospel of Mark
Session 26 – July 31st – Chapter 14

v.1 One of Mark's only dates given. (Wednesday, April 1st, A.D. 33)

vv. 3-9 Who is this woman? (See Jn. 12) How many days before Passover was this? What was the nard/perfume worth? Why was this not wasted? Who started the conversation about waste?

vv. 10-11

vv. 12-21 "On the first day of unleavened bread", i.e., Day of Preparation for Passover (Thursday, April 2nd, A.D. 33)

Another prediction. How does it unfold?

"And when it was evening" = Now its Friday.

vv. 22-31 The Lord's Supper

Another prediction. How is it about to unfold?

The Garden of Gethsemane:

vv. 32-42 In prayer (& sleep)

vv. 43-52 Betrayal & Arrest. Who is the young man in vv. 51-52?

vv. 53-65 False Trial before the High Priest. Fulfillment of passion predictions.

vv. 66-72 Peter's denial. Fulfillment of Jesus' words earlier that evening.

The chapters ahead:

16 The resurrection – Jesus' prophecies come true, III
